

HISTORY OF ST. AUGUSTINE CHAPTER No. 3108

Warranted: 6th August 1924

Consecrated: 29th September 1924

Meetings: Fourth Thursday in January, March, April, September and November

Installation: September

There is no information regarding the background reasons for the founding of the Chapter as the majority of their records as well as those of St Augustine Lodge (the sponsoring Lodge) and Beaufort Chapter (from where the majority of the senior members came) were destroyed by enemy action. No doubt the founding was due to demand as well as encouragement from Provincial Grand Chapter.

The majority of the new members are listed as being members of Chapter 103 - this was the Beaufort Chapter. 13 Worshipful Masters of the St Augustine Lodge were founding members of the Chapter. Nine Master Masons of St Augustine Lodge were also founder members giving a total of 21 from St Augustine Lodge

However, new chapters had to be sponsored by and attached to existing Lodges and would take on the same number, therefore, St Augustine Lodge No. 3108 took on this role

The present Registration Book covers the period from 1924 to the present day and records over 400 Exaltees and further joining members
